- To support Spiritualism New Zealand by promoting the organisation and its activities.
- To not speak or act in any way that will bring Spiritualism New Zealand or its members into disrepute.

This Code of Ethics is a guideline only and does not represent the full range of good conduct and ethical behaviour expected of members of Spiritualism New Zealand. Acceptance of this Code is a condition of membership.
