



## **SPIRITUALISM NEW ZEALAND HEALING MANUAL**

### ***11.3 On-going requirements & support after registration***

#### ***11.3.1 Abiding by the SNZ Code of Ethics for Spiritual Healers***

Continuing to abide by the latest Code of Ethics for Spiritual Healers helps ensure your own safety and that of the people that you are healing, whether from a physical, ethical or legal perspective. It also helps maintain your reputation as a trustworthy and competent spiritual healer, and that of all other Spiritualism New Zealand (SNZ) accredited spiritual healers.

#### ***11.3.2 Undergo a police vetting check every five years***

Every five years, you will be asked to complete a police vetting form for SNZ and provide the required proof of identity. If the result of that vet is not satisfactory, you and any organisation for whom you heal will be advised and your qualification as a registered spiritual healer may be removed. If removed, your insurance cover will also cease. If satisfactory, nothing will change in regard to your healer status.

As spiritual healers, we can be healing vulnerable people including the very young, the very old and the mentally challenged. The regular police vet is part of SNZ's processes to ensure our healers remain ethical and safe to work with. Again, this helps preserve the good reputation of all SNZ accredited spiritual healers.

#### ***11.3.3 Attend a healing course for registered spiritual healers each year with a Spiritualism New Zealand trainer***

This requirement is to ensure you remain up to date with best practice spiritual healing and any other changes that may affect us, such as changes to laws. Once these advanced courses are established, they will be advertised by the spiritual healing trainers running them on the SNZ website in the Events [www.spiritualism.org.nz/events-calendar-2/#!event-list](http://www.spiritualism.org.nz/events-calendar-2/#!event-list) . Until they are established, registered healers will be exempt from meeting the requirement to attend annual courses.

Spiritual healing is not a static modality and it will continue to change as people, energies and the social environment change. This requirement to continue to stay up-to-date with the latest training, helps spiritual healers to remain relevant, effective and safe in an ever-changing world.



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### **11.3.4 On-going support**

SNZ and its spiritual healing trainers will stay up-to-date with the latest advancements in spiritual healing so that information can be passed on to all spiritual healers through basic spiritual healing course and then the continued professional development training courses for registered healers.

If a SNZ course, trainer or healer falls short of your expectations, complaints can be made through the same avenues.

SNZ will continue to source Public Liability and Statutory Liability insurance for all its spiritual healers. This cover may change as insurers change their options available.
